



**Herbert Protocol** is an information gathering tool for a person living with dementia who has gone missing, as quickly as possible. **If you are concerned about a person living with dementia and believe they are missing, this is an emergency and you MUST dial 999.**

This form is designed to be completed by a family member/friend/neighbour with copies of the form being held by all relevant people. It is a good idea to fill this form in after diagnosis so you are prepared. Keep it as up-to-date as possible.
