**REQUEST**

**Request**

- 1) How many arrests have been made for child sexual exploitation in connection with Rotherham CSE from 2001 -2012
- 2) How many arrests have been made for child sexual exploitation across South Yorkshire from 2001 – 2012
- 3) Would you please supply the information requested for each year?

**RESPONSE**

South Yorkshire Police the information you request. However, we will not be supplying this to you in full.

Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires South Yorkshire Police, when refusing to provide such information (because the information is exempt), to provide you the applicant with a notice which:

- a. states that fact,
- b. specifies the exemption in question and
- c. states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies).

The exemption applicable to your request falls under Section 21.

**Section 21 *'Information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant'*.**
